Rev. Dr. Ca Trice Glenn

Rev. Dr. Ca Trice Glenn, LPC, ACS has dedicated her life to fulfilling her God-inspired purpose of equipping and empowering others. A licensed professional counselor, approved clinical supervisor, ordained minister, and practical theologian based in the Atlanta, Georgia area, she brings gifts of teaching and counseling that resonate with individuals and groups of all ages. She is the founder and director of Solace Counseling and Consulting LLC, the host of The TheoTherapist Podcast, and the founder of Church Mental Health Training.

In 2012, Dr. Glenn earned a Doctor of Theology in Pastoral Counseling from the Candler School of Theology at Emory University, where she now serves as a Teaching Supervisor in the Contextual Education Program. Her dissertation examined the role of spirituality in the resilience of young adult survivors of childhood trauma. She also holds a Master of Divinity from McAfee School of Theology and a Master of Science in Community Counseling from Mercer University, and she teaches mental health courses across undergraduate and graduate programs.

A pastoral counselor in private practice, a nationally certified licensed professional counselor, and an approved clinical supervisor, Dr. Glenn previously served as Director of Counseling at Life University and as a personal counselor to students at Perimeter College of Georgia State University before devoting more time to her practice. Dr. Glenn joined Hopewell Missionary Baptist Church in Norcross in 1998 and was ordained in 2011. At Hopewell, she has served as Director of Counseling for the Hopewell Counseling Ministry and Associate Pastor with Youth. In the community she has served as a Level II chaplain in hospitals and volunteer chaplain juvenile detention facilities and sports entertainment settings.

In 2022, Dr. Glenn released Brain Dump Journal for the Busy, a four-book journal series for busy women, men, college students, and teens. She launched The TheoTherapist Podcast in 2023, hosting bi-vocational licensed therapists with theological training who share healing perspectives at the intersection of theology and therapy, and in 2024 she introduced Church Mental Health Response Training to equip church leaders with theologically integrated best practices and mental health response skills. Most importantly, Dr. Glenn wants her life to reflect the love she has for God and God's people, especially God's children.
